Q – How do I become a provider of the BCU FSRT Course

A – Complete the following training and log book requirements.

Training

A full day module presented within the Home nations on a demand led basis. The day will be spent running through the FSRT syllabus and trainers notes with at least half a day spent on water, ensuring that participants are conversant with the safety issues, key learning points and are able to provide an accurate demonstrations (3* standard).

Pre-requisites

Minimum pre-requisite current Level 3 or have been a BCU (UKCC) Level 2 for 3 years.

Registration

Candidates should register with their Home Nation Coaching office.

Outcomes

Participants design their own action plan which is discussed and agreed with the training provider. This action plan is then written into their BCU FSRT Providers log. Training provider will sign log to verify training has been completed.

Candidates complete the log book requirements and submit to their home nation coaching officer for verification. On successful verification candidates will be registered as FSRT Providers.
