# MENTORING FOR PADDLESPORT COACHES Presented by Stuart Briggs

**A BCU Foundation Module** 

#### 3 hours

The module intends to equip coaches with a definition of modern mentoring. Identifying its principles, elements of best practice and the vocabulary which current mentor education embraces.

Becoming a mentor is challenging and rewarding in equal measures. It is challenging because you are actively involved in the professional development of the coach and the long term improvement of paddlesport coaching. There is therefore a responsibility to be as knowledgeable and enthusiastic about recent developments in coaching and coach education. It is rewarding because as a mentor you will have opportunities to articulate your own perspective, views and beliefs about coaching to another coach effectively reflecting on your own thinking and practice. As the mentor to another coach you will inevitably become involved with their delivery of coaching, touching along the way on personal and professional activities associated with the coaches development. This interaction will stimulate your own understanding of coaching, bringing professional activity and debate into the process. In conclusion there is a profit for both parties engaged in a mentoring process and it should be appreciated that this is an exciting and demanding context in which a coach can develop professionally.

#### **Fundamentals Workshop**
